RULES APPLICABLE TO NOMINATIONS :

1. All nominations forms are to be submitted to the chairman of the J.S.S. Committee by the 7th day of the month following the nominee's sporting achievement.
2. The age of the nominee is to be less than 16 years at the time of nomination, and a financial member of the W.S.C. Inc. for the whole of the J.S.S. year.
3. The J.S.S. year is from May to the following year for the month of April.
4. For any one month, there can be no more than 3 monthly sportstars selected, depending on achievement levels as determined by the selection panel.
5. During April, from a possible maximum of 36 monthly J.S.S.'s a "Sportstar of the Year" is then selected by the panel.

6. Nominations must be approved by the Divisional Committee where the nomination is originated, prior to submitting to the J.S.S. Committee for achievement recognition.

Nomination forms are available from the General Secretary of the Club (Mrs. Lynne Burns) or the Chairman of the J.S.S. Committee (Mr. Bob Burns).

Operation of the Junior Sportstar awards system is solely dependent on NOMINATION INPUTS from the Junior Divisions.

Unfortunately several of the club's Junior members in the past having achieved high levels in sporting performances have missed out on the acknowledgment they thoroughly deserve due to lack of nomination. This has occurred either due to a lack of knowledge of the J.S.S. monthly awards, or a selection from some coaches of managers to submit suitable nominations, especially where team games are concerned.

The Annual J.S.S. Dinner and Presentations function is an important clubmanship activity, and is a form of encouragement Juniors require and benefit from as part of their sporting activity when considering their future.
