In our 10th Anniversary Year we continue our look at the early years of the Club as recorded in the minutes of the Board of Control.

Board Meeting 27/11/75

Little Athletics reported the election of a new Divisional Secretary—Marlene Hislop.

David Ellis (Secretary of Chess and cricket player) had been selected as the Chess Association of WA nominee for Sportsman of the Year.

With the resignation of Roy Young (transferred to Sydney) an election for the position of Club President was held. Eric Crump was duly elected.

The meeting also viewed plans of the proposed developments on Burrendah Reserve which had been drawn up by Council in conjunction with the Club. The preferred

order or priority for the various facilities was decided as follows:

Stage 1—Skateboard area, 4 basketball courts, 4 netball courts, 5 tennis courts, picnic area, hockey and cricket hard wicket with practice nets, car parking and changeroom and storage facilities.

Stage 2 - Main changeroom, toilet and storage facilities, youth centre and community hall, remaining grassed playing areas including

turf cricket wicket and practice area, adventure playground, further car parking.

Stage 3 - Five extra tennis courts, sports hall, car parking and landscaping.

Stage 4—Bowling greens and final carpark development.

(It is interesting that most items in Stage 1 of this 1975 plan have in fact been implemented - Stage 2 still has a lot of work to be done!)

Board Meeting 18/12/75

A position of Vice President being vacant, four nominations were received. Brian Lewis was duly elected.

Little Athletics reported a successful Walkabout which raised about \$500.

The meeting was informed that Alan Giles has leaving the district. It was agreed that a "Road Runner" T-Shirt be presented to Alan in appreciation of his services to the Club (Alan was instrumental in starting jnr cricket in Willetton and also coached for almost 3 seasons).
